- A majority of survey takers are 16 (~24%) and 17 (~30%) years old.

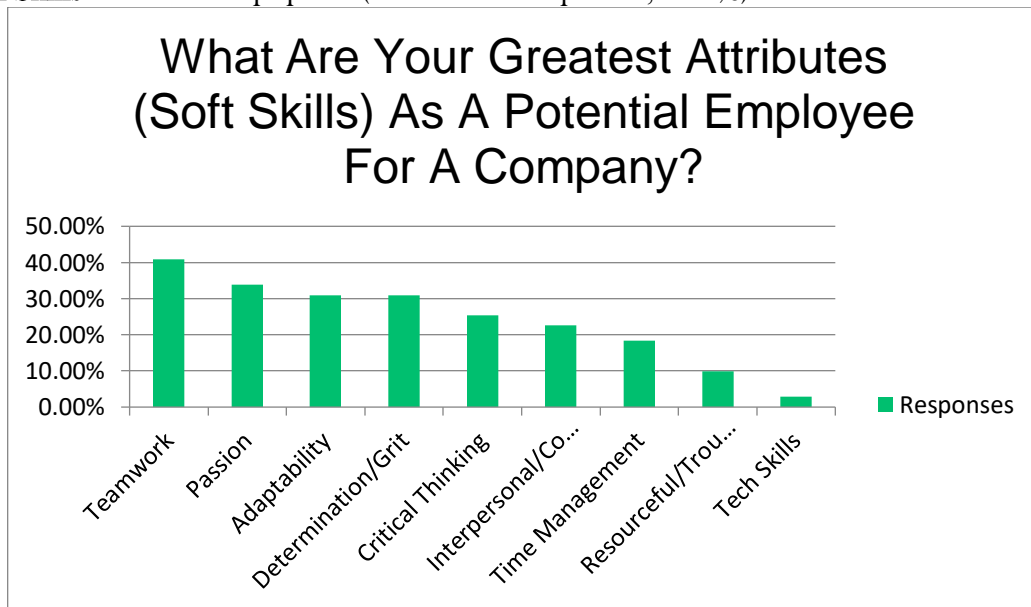
Q6 How Eager Are You To Get A Blue Job/Career To Help Rebuild The Planet?

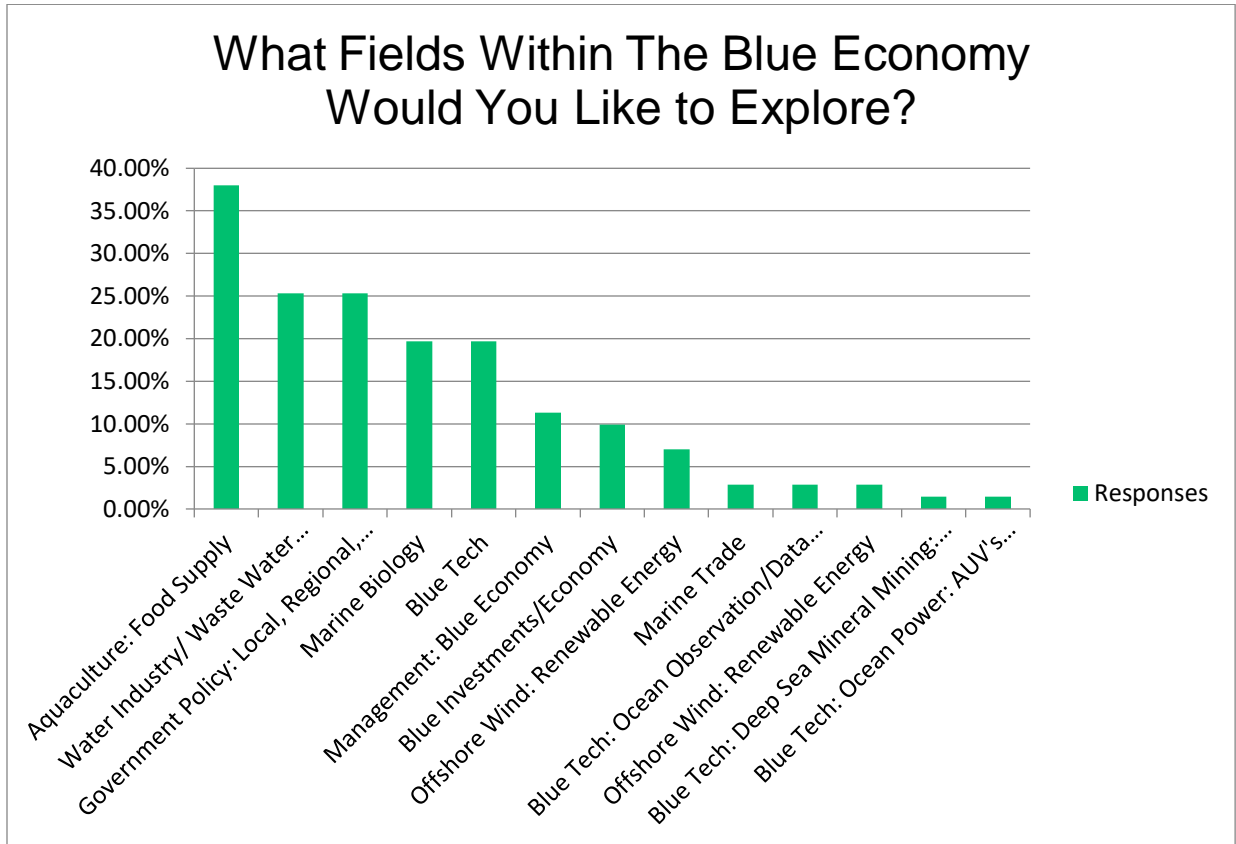
Q7 What Are Your Greatest Attributes (Soft Skills) As A Potential Employee For A Company?

- **Tech Skills** was the least popular (chosen in 2 responses, 2.82%)



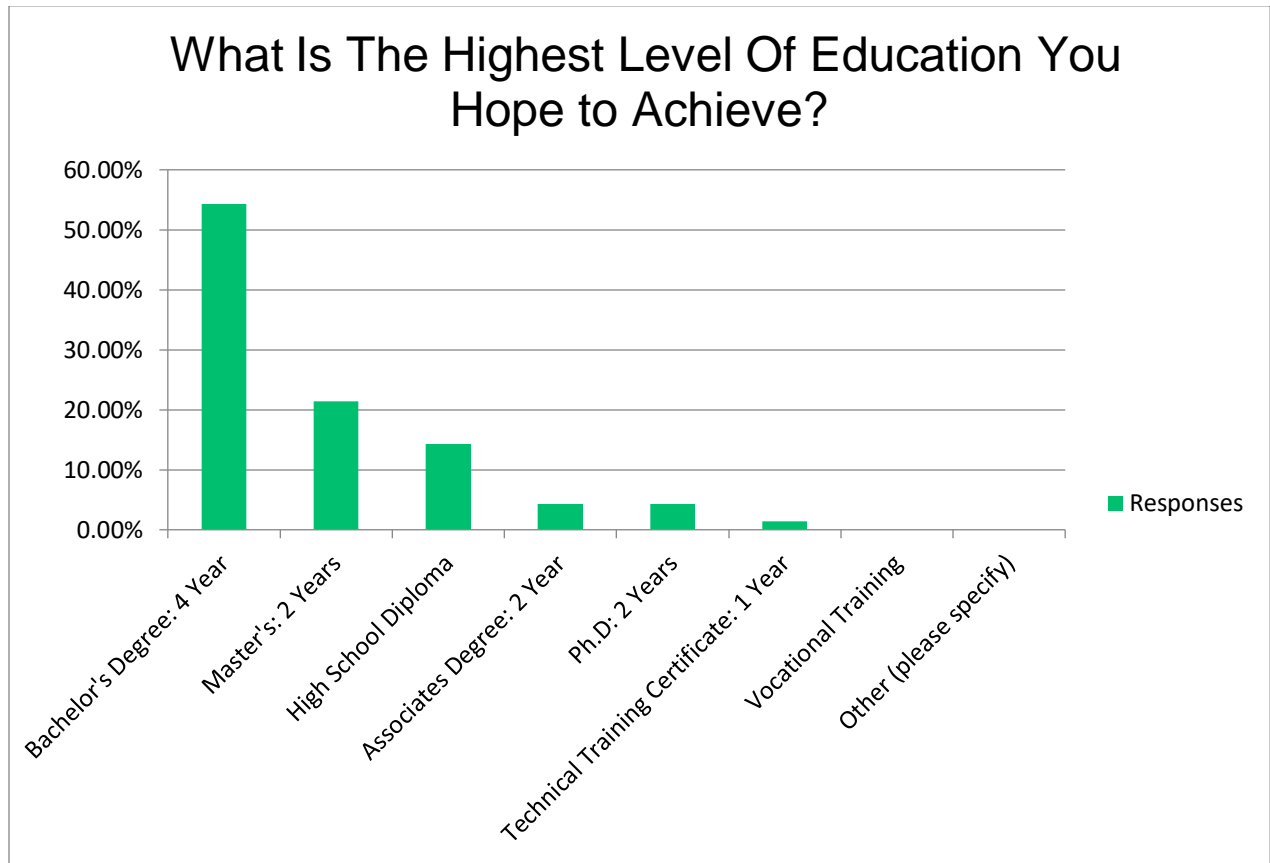
Q8 What Fields Within The Blue Economy Would You Like to Explore?

- **Aquaculture: Food Supply** was the most popular response (chosen in 27 response, 38.03%)
- **Blue Tech: Ocean Power, AUVs Sensors, Buoys** was the least popular (chosen in 1 response, 1.41%)
- **Blue Tech: Deep Sea Mineral Mining** was also chosen in 1 response, 1.41%)

- **Technical Training** was chosen once 1.43%

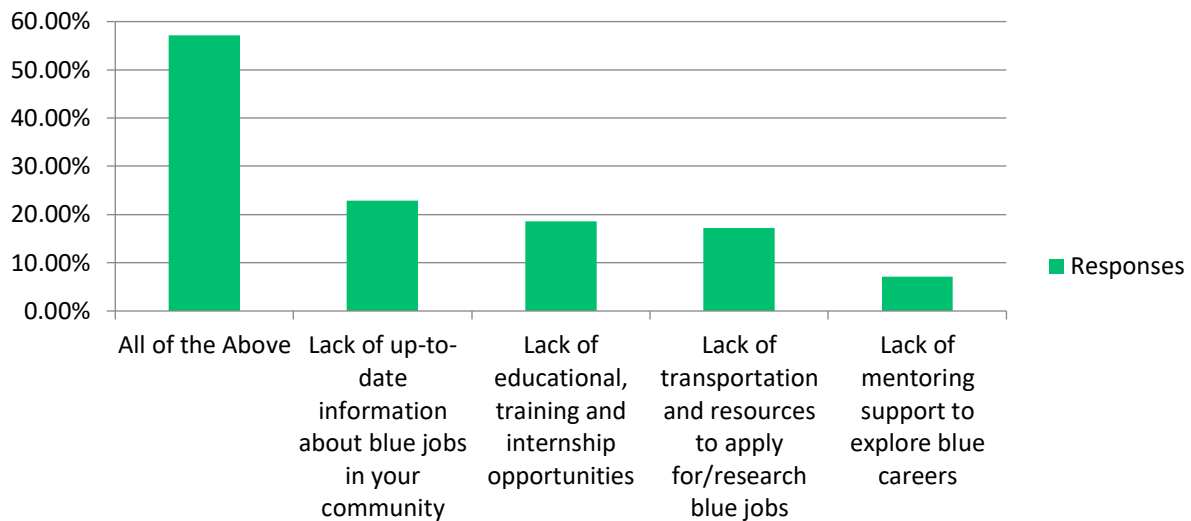


Q10 What Are The Biggest Challenges Facing Young Adults Applying For Blue And Green Jobs?

- **Lack of Up-to-date information about blue jobs in your community** (16, 22.86%)
- **Lack of Educational, training and internship opportunities** (13, 18.57%)
- **Lack of Transportation and resources to apply for/research blue jobs** (12, 17.14%)
- **Lack of mentoring support to explore blue careers** (5, 7.14%)
- **All of the above** (40, 57.14%)

A majority of respondents chose all of the issues as challenges that they face when applying for blue/green jobs.

What Are The Biggest Challenges Facing Young Adults Applying For Blue And Green Jobs?

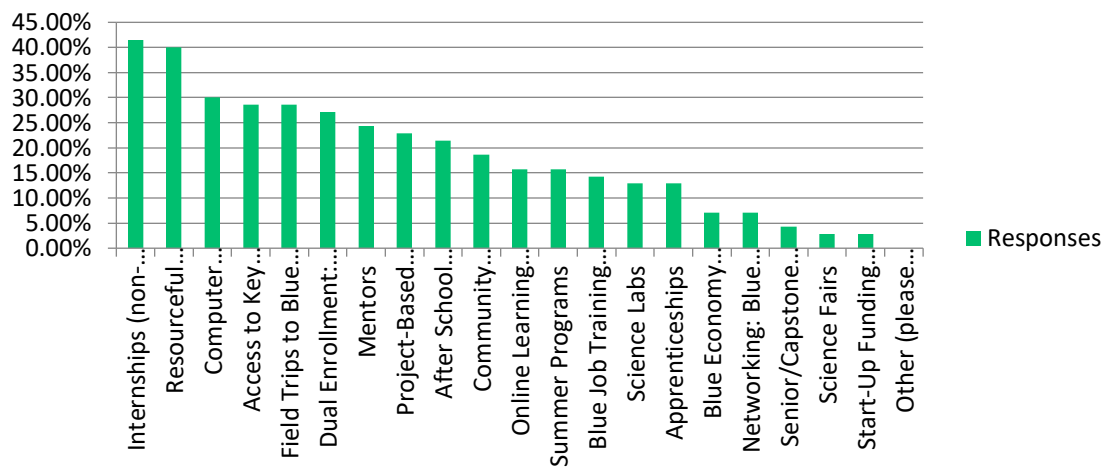


Q11 What Resources Are Most Important to You to Pursue Your Ideal Career Pathway?

What Resources Are Most Important to You to Pursue Your Ideal Career Pathway?



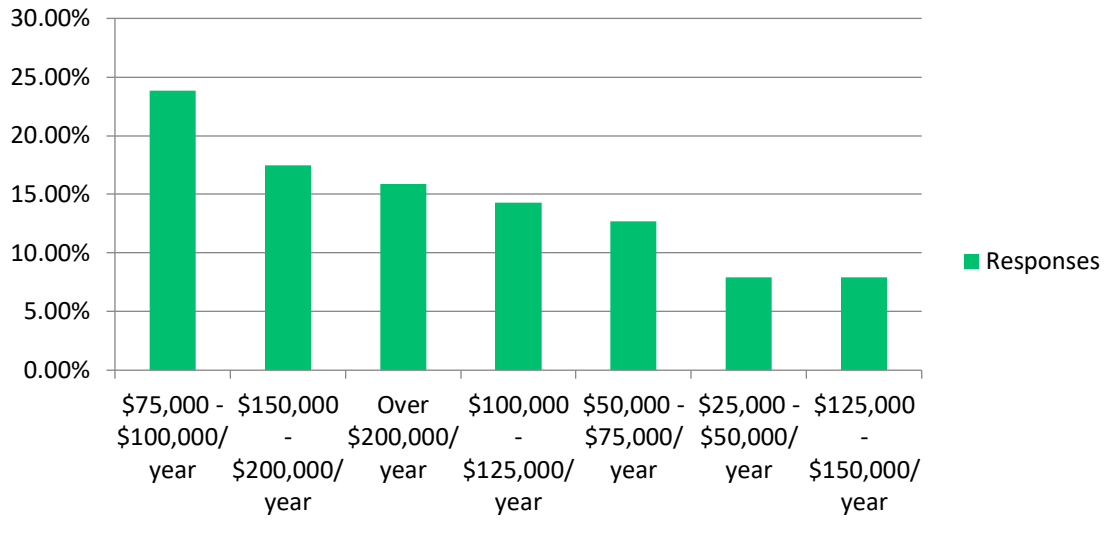
