



Monday: Quote


According to UNHCR, the UN's refugee agency, 21.5 million people were forcibly displaced each year by weather-related events – floods, storms, wildfires and extreme temperatures – from 2008 to 2016. There could be 1.2 billion climate refugees by 2050. A collective effort is needed to solve the issue of climate migration and help the "world's forgotten victims" of climate change.


