


Stone Soup Leadership Institute's Story of the Week: Paul Newman: Newman's Own Week of May 5 - 11, 2024



Sunday: Paul Newman: Newman's Own

Read how Paul Newman, the famous actor became "...America's biggest philanthropist in proportion to his own wealth."

"Newman's Own began as a lark, a joke more or less, and soon became a challenge...I had no idea that my salad dressing would outgross my films," he says. "Today there's an entire generation that may know me more for my popcorn than for my movies."

Among his favorite endeavors is the Newman's Own and Good House-keeping Recipe Contest, in which winners receive \$10,000 for their favorite charity. The winning story is featured in Stone

Soup for the World and in the Stone Soup Educational Curriculum.


Thursday: The Institute's Book Signing
