



Read How Fleece Revolutionized the Outdoor Industry

In the late 1970s, Malden Mills, spearheaded the development of this new fabric that would revolutionize the outdoor apparel industry. Drawing inspiration from natural wool, Feuerstein and his team were experimenting with different ways to knit polyester yarns and stumbled upon an unusual lofty style that had some amazing characteristics. They branded this unique fabric as "Polar Fleece"

From its humble beginnings as a synthetic alternative to wool, fleece has evolved into a functional yet


